Westminster Foodbank

Care professionals such as health visitors, staff at schools and social workers identify people in crisis and issue them with a **food bank voucher**. This means people can receive a food bank parcel of three days' nutritionally balanced, non-perishable food from their local food bank.

Local Support Payment

If you need help because of an **emergency** or a **crisis** you may be entitled to a Local Support Payment (LSP). You may also qualify if you need help to remain or settle in the community. There is no automatic entitlement, this is a discretionary scheme and they base their decision on every individual case.

The local support payment phone line is open from 9am to 5pm Monday to Friday.
